## **Important information for our expectant mothers**

There is a supplemental social security income for families of very premature babies. Families are urged to contact their local Social Security office as soon as their babies are born, if they weigh under 1,200 grams (2.6 pounds) at birth. It seems there is a Supplemental Social Security Income that is available to families (\$466.00 per child, per month), to help with the overwhelming costs associated with such early births. During the time of hospitalization, there is no consideration of parent's income or resources. Later, when the babies come home, family income is taken into consideration for further help if it is needed, but there is often additional help available.

Evidentially, it is rare for hospital social workers to alert families of this benefit, and it is not retroactive. SSI should be called immediately following the birth of the babies. One mother said that since the benefit is so new, it is important to be persistent and to file an "intent to file" if the local SS worker is uninformed and to follow through to be sure the proper paperwork is taken care of. When needed, Medicaid is also made available to some upon application for SSI.

**For more information about the SSI program and children, call Social Security's toll free telephone number, (800) 772-1213 M-F 7 am to 7 pm. The best time to call is early in the morning, late in the afternoon, late in the week, and toward the end of the month. Or, contact your local Social Security office. Ask for the leaflet, Social Security and SSI For Children With Disabilities.**

#### Tips for Organizing and Pricing for the Sale

Please note these are just suggestions!!!

##### ORGANIZING:

- \* T-shirts: group 3 to a set in a zip-loc bag. Usually sell for \$.25-\$.50 each or \$.75-\$1.50 for a set
- \* Shoes: Shoes have not typically sold well. Place in zip-loc bags or tie the laces together (so they won't get separated). Shoes will sell for \$1.00-\$5.00.
- \* Socks: Group 2-3 like pairs of socks to a bag. Socks will sell anywhere from \$.25-\$1.50/pair.
- \* Put nicer clothing on hangers (these seem to sell well). They will sell for \$3.00-\$6.00
- \* Group stuffed animals and small toys together \$.25-\$3.00

##### PRICING (Try to avoid selling stained or very worn clothing)

###### Clothing

- \* t-shirts (\$.50-\$2.50), \* pajamas/sleepers: \$.50-\$3.00, \* pants (\$1.50-\$4.00),
- \* playsuits/overalls (\$3.00-\$5.00), \* dresses (\$3.00-\$6.00), \* shirts (\$1.00-\$3.50), \* jackets (\$5.00-\$8.00)
- \* sweaters (\$2.00-\$5.00), \* maternity clothing \$2.00-\$20.00 \* preemie clothing can be priced a bit higher, brands such as gymboree, old navy, Disney store can be priced higher.

###### Toys and Equipment

- \* books \$.25-\$2.00, \* videos \$2.00-\$5.00, \* puzzles and books - \$.25-\$4.00
- \* large toys in good condition price at 1/2 retail, \* small toys: \$.25-\$5.00
- \* furniture/equipment in good condition, you can price 1/3-1/2 retail.

*Also if you are not working the sale and really want to get rid of an item be sure to let someone know the lowest price you will take for the item.*
